


## Grundfos UPM3 - Anti Blocking Concept



The deblocking axial moving plunger tightened by an oring and pulled back by a spring inside a stainless steel housing that is welded to the rotor

The de-blocking device is designed for circulators integrated into appliances to give access to the shaft fromt he front without demounting the control box


By pushing and turning a screw driver Phillips No. 2, the plunger pushes the shaft in axial direction into the circuator, while it can be turned as well.



The force is high enough to de-block circulators which are seized by lime e.g. If an appliance is stored for months after being wet tested.



Deblocking device




Sectional drawing of deblocking device

Before, during and after the deblocking, the device is tight and must not release any water


In case of deblocking functionality the UPM3 is equipped with a double safety solution:



### Manual De-blocking Function






The manual de-blocking device consists of a plunger that axially moves and is sealed in by an o-ring.

The plunger is retracted by a spring which is covered with a stainless steel housing that is welded on top of the rotor can.

The pump should be powered and running whilst attempting to manually clear the blockage.





### Fault Finding



Fa	ult	Cause	Remedy
1.	Pump is not running. No	System is switched off.	Check the system controller.
	power supply.	<ul> <li>A fuse in the installation is blown.</li> </ul>	Replace the fuse.
		The circuit breaker has tripped.	Check the power connection and switch on the circuit breaker.
		Power supply failure.	Check the power supply.
2.	Pump is not running. Normal power supply.	<ul> <li>Controller is switched off.</li> </ul>	Check the controller and its settings.
		Pump is blocked by impurities.	Remove impurities. Deblock the pump from the front of the control box with a screwdriver.
		<ul> <li>Pump is defective.</li> </ul>	Replace the pump.
3.	Pump runs at maximum speed and cannot be controlled.	No signal from signal cable.	Check if the cable is connected to the controller. If it is, replace the cable.
4.	Noise in the system.	Air in the system.	Vent the system.
		Differential pressure is too high.	Reduce the pump performance at the pump or external controller.
5.	Noise in the pump.	Air in the pump.	Let the pump run. The pump vents itself over time.
		Inlet pressure is too low.	Increase the system pressure or check the air volume in the expansion tank, if installed.
6.	Insufficient flow.	<ul> <li>Pump performance is too low.</li> </ul>	Check the external controller and the pump settings.
		<ul> <li>Hydraulic system is closed or system pressure i insufficient.</li> </ul>	S Check the non-return valve and filter, Increase the system pressure.
7.	Pump LED5 is on. Pump tries to restart every 1.5 sec.	Rotor shaft is blocked.	Deblock the rotor shaft by pushing it with a screwdriver from the front of the pump.








Grundfos UPM3 pumps are warranted for 24 months from the date of supply or 30 months from the date of manufacture.

See image to left for manufacturing date.


The manufacture date can be found on the data plate on the pump head under the PC number.

18 – Year of manufacture



- Talk customer through de-blocking process.
- Refer customer to their plumber.
- If plumber has no success refer them to Grundfos Telephone 01942 263628.
- The caller will be transferred to the Workshop Team.

#### Grundfos Workshop Team will –

- Go through simple deblocking process with customer.
- Recommend back to plumber or if it is the plumber, continue with process.
- Grundfos will send out a new pump under warranty to the customer.
- Grundfos will arrange to collect the faulty pump from customer via TNT
